



## **NY State ID Card or Driver's License – J-1 Students**

**Step 1:** Go to the Social Security Office to receive a letter that says you are NOT eligible for a Social Security number.

**You must bring the following documents with you to the Social Security Office:**

- A copy of your class schedule
- Official Transcript (Go to the Office of the Registrar located on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the 43<sup>rd</sup> street building to receive this. It costs \$10)
- Student ID Card, DS-2019, Passport, Visa, Most Recent I-94

The office is between Fulton and John Streets near the 2,3,4,5,A,C,R and Z subway lines and the PATH train.

**Step 2:** Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV)

**You must bring the following documents with you to the DMV that total 4 points:**

- Letter from the Social Security Office
- Passport, J-1 Visa, DS-2019 and Most Recent I-94 Printout (3 points)
- Student ID Card and Transcript (2 points)
- U.S. Health Insurance Card (1 point)
- U.S. Utility Bill (must include your name and address, 1 point)
- ONE of the following (1 point):
  - U.S. bank card (ATM or credit card)
  - U.S. bank statement

**\*\*If applying for a Driver's License you must first take a written test to receive a permit. Please be prepared to take the test before you go to the DMV with the above documents. Information on how to receive a permit is available at: <https://dmv.ny.gov/driver-license/get-learner-permit>**
