Change Of Address

J-1 Exchange Visitors are required to report changes of address or contact information to the International Division **within 10 days** of the change.

*Please also make sure you use Engage to update your contact information as needed. You must update your address both online and with an advisor.

Travel

Students are required to meet with an International Advisor before traveling outside the US. Travel signatures are required on your DS-2019's.

J-1 visitors are allowed a 30-day grace period beyond the end date on their DS-2019, during which you may prepare to leave or travel within the U.S. This additional 30-day period **cannot** be used for employment, extensions, or transfers.

If you travel outside the U.S. during your 30-day grace period, you forfeit the remaining grace period and **may not** re-enter the U.S. under J-1 status.

Health Insurance

For the entire duration of your J-1 Exchange Visitor Program at Berkeley College, you are responsible for obtaining and maintaining medical insurance coverage.

Failure to comply with the medical insurance coverage requirements of the Exchange Visitor Program Regulations will constitute a violation and may result in termination of your affiliation with Berkeley College, and termination of your J-1 status.

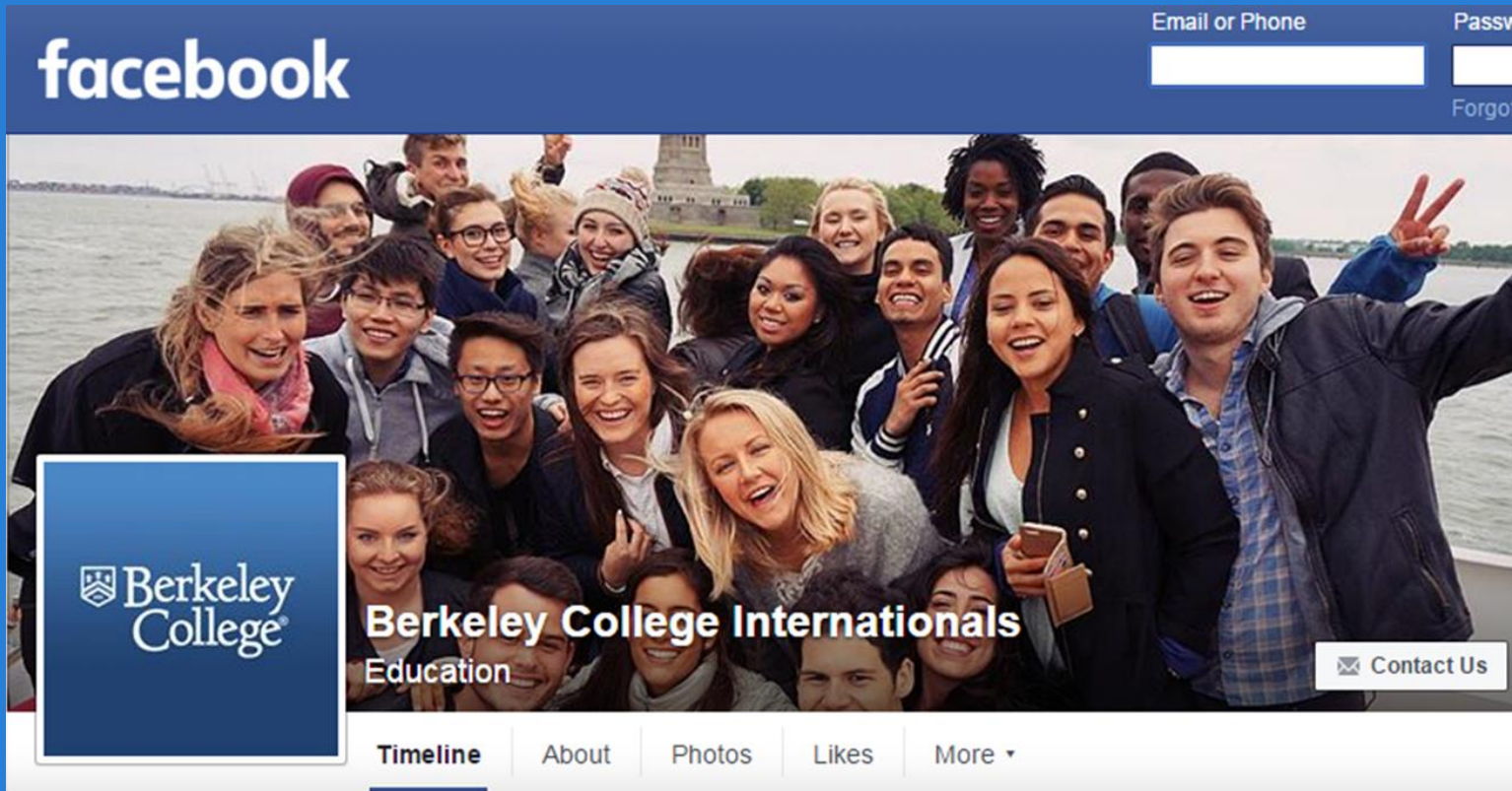
